## Background Information

The Dining Society (TDS) is a private members club which provides opportunities for students in the hospitality industry to practise both their professional and communication skills in an authentic restaurant setting.

Whilst dining with us, members and their guests are also encouraged to speak English or Putonghua with our students and thus strengthening their language proficiency.

TDS members are warmly welcomed to participate in regular chef demonstrations at our demonstration kitchens, to enjoy themed dinners at our Training Restaurants in addition to weekday lunches and to indulge in designated services within specific time period offered at The T Hotel and Training Spa.

For the enjoyment of all members and guests, in addition to other bylaws, we politely remind that:

- Student interests are our utmost priority and individual safety and campus security are of primary concern at our Institutes. During adverse weather conditions or under special circumstances, we may adjust the practical training schedule and operations of the training restaurants to ensure individual safety and try to minimise the impact on our TDS members as far as possible
- TDS provides services to members only and memberships are not transferable. Guests must be accompanied by members showing valid TDS membership cards
- To minimise food wastage and better allocate our training resources, advance restaurant booking and cancellations are required
- Parking spaces are not guaranteed and are available on a first-come-first-served basis
- Business or smart casual attire (no shorts and sport sandals) is required when dining in our Restaurants. Students and instructor-in-charge reserve the right to refuse entry to those whose attire does not conform to the requirements
- All mobile devices be silenced in our Restaurants
- Children below the age of 12 are not permitted
- A booking of maximum 8 guests (western restaurant) and 12 guests (Chinese restaurant) is restricted per member per meal period (including member)
- Booking will be taken at a maximum of one month in advance

## Additional Information

- Chinese cuisine is served in Pokfulam, while western/international cuisine is served in both Pokfulam and Kowloon Bay
- Our Training Restaurants are open for lunch from 12:00 noon to 2:30pm<sup>^</sup> on Mondays to Fridays, except public holidays. In addition, western/international themed dinners are regularly offered
- Dinners are served in the Chinese Training Restaurant Friday evenings from 6:00pm to 9:30pm<sup>^</sup>, except public holidays
- The number of seats available and table configuration in the Training Restaurants will vary depending on the daily training arrangements and other concurrent events
